PARTICIPANT AGREEMENT, RELEASE AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK

In consideration of the services of O.A.R.S. Canyonlands, Inc., its agents, owners, officers, volunteers, participants, employees and all other persons or entities acting in any capacity on its behalf (hereinafter collectively referred to as "OARS"), I hereby release and discharge OARS on behalf of myself, my children, my parents, my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and estate as follows:

1. I acknowledge that boating on rivers entails known and unanticipated risks, which could result in physical or emotional injury, paralysis, death or damage to me, to third parties or to property. I understand that such risks simply cannot be eliminated without jeopardizing the essential qualities of the activity. **The risks include, among other things:**

Boating on rivers and through whitewater rapids	Swimming along rocky and sandy shores
Riding in a jet boat or motorized launch	Riding in a shuttle vehicle and/or small plane
4x4 vehicle trips over rough terrain	Horseback riding
Canyoneering/Climbing/Rappelling	
Hiking and walking in camp and on trails and rocky ridges with steep and slippery slopes	
Bicycling on paved and dirt roads, slick rock, streams, trails and other unstable surfaces	

I understand I may be exposed to sun, insects, cold water, environmental hazards, biting or stinging animal life and forces of nature. I can be jolted, jarred, bounced, thrown to and fro and shaken about through rapids, hitting sandbars or river debris, or traveling in a vehicle through rough terrain on rugged roads. It is possible that I could be injured if I come in contact with storage containers or other fixed equipment necessary to the operation of the trip and the outfitting of the boat. Boats could turn over or I could be washed overboard. I can slip or fall during a hike. Boats are slippery when wet. Accidents can occur getting on and off boats. My vehicle could malfunction, come to sudden stops, experience impact, slide, roll or otherwise lose control. Ropes, knots and anchors may fail. Climbing harnesses can malfunction and falls may occur. Exposure to the natural elements could cause sunburn, dehydration, heat exhaustion, heat stroke and heat cramps. Exposure to cold water can result in hypothermia and, in extreme cases, death. Accidental drowning is also a possibility. I could be hurt by unanticipated movement of rocks, soil or trees. Equipment could break down in a remote area. I understand OARS employees have difficult jobs to perform. They seek safety, but they are not infallible. They might be unaware of my fitness or abilities. They might misjudge the weather or other environmental conditions. They may give incomplete warnings or instructions, and the equipment being used might malfunction.

I understand the trip may take place in rugged outdoor conditions (including camping) that contain inherent dangers due to weather, back-country terrain, the canyon or river environment, local flora and fauna and distance from hospital facilities. I understand that the planned itinerary may be changed on account of weather conditions, equipment problems or natural disasters, creating travel delays.

2. I am aware that whitewater boating and backcountry vehicle travel entails risks of injury or death to any participant. I understand the description of these risks is not complete and that other unknown or unanticipated risks may result in injury or death. I expressly agree and promise to accept and assume full responsibility all of the risks existing in this activity including the inherent risks identified herein and those inherent risks not specifically identified. My participation is purely voluntary, and I elect to participate in spite of and with full understanding of the risks. I acknowledge that engaging in this activity may require a degree of skill and knowledge

to more fully explain to me the nature and physical demands of this activity and the inherent risks, hazards, and dangers associated with this activity.

I certify that I am fully capable of participating in this activity. Therefore, I assume and accept full responsibility for myself, including all minor children in my care, custody and control, for bodily injury, death or loss of personal property and expenses as a result of those inherent risks and dangers identified herein and those inherent risks and dangers not specifically identified, and, as a result of my negligence in participating in this activity. I am not relying on any oral, written or visual representations made by OARS, including those made in brochures or other promotional materials, to induce me to go on this whitewater rafting adventure.

3. I hereby voluntarily release, forever discharge, and agree to indemnify and hold harmless OARS from any and all claims, demands, or causes of action, which are in any way connected with my participation in this activity or my use of OARS equipment or facilities, **including any such claims which allege negligent acts or omissions of OARS.**

4. I certify that I have adequate insurance to cover any injury or damage I may cause or suffer while participating, or else I agree to bear the costs of such injury or damage myself. I further certify that I have no medical or physical conditions which could interfere with my safety in this activity, or else I agree to bear the costs of all risks that may be created, directly or indirectly, by any such condition.

5. Should OARS or anyone acting on its or their behalf, be required to incur attorney's fees and costs to enforce this agreement, I agree to indemnify and hold them harmless for all such fees and costs. In the event that I file a lawsuit against OARS, I agree to do so solely in Calaveras County in the State of California, where OARS has its headquarters, and I further agree that the substantive law of that state shall apply in that action without regard to the conflict of law rules of that state. I agree that if any portion of this agreement is found to be void or unenforceable, the remaining portions shall remain in full force and effect.

6. I grant permission to OARS and other trip participants to make movies, videos and photographs and to use them for promotional and commercial purposes without recourse or compensation to me.

By signing this document, I acknowledge that if anyone is hurt or property is damaged during my participation in this activity, I may be found by a court of law to have waived my right to maintain a lawsuit against O.A.R.S. Canyonlands, Inc., on the basis of any claim from which I have released them herein.

I have had sufficient opportunity to read this entire document. I have carefully read and clearly understood it, and I agree to be bound by its terms.
